For confirmation, I usually ask the young people being confirmed to submit their favorite "church" song for us to sing in worship that day. This year, I was struck that 3 out of our 4 young people had the same favorite. You see the words above.

I won't have a chance to ask these students about this song before our newsletter deadline, but I plan to see about this song draws them in.

In worship this summer most of our gospel texts focus in on what it means to follow Jesus, what it means to be a disciple, what it means to profess God's name in good times and in not so good times. It's a continuation of Luther's words about sanctification, that we are "not being, but becoming...we are not yet what we shall be, but we are growing towards it, the process is not finished, but it is going on. This is not the end, but it is the road". The texts explore what it means to be a disciple, what it means to day by day try to love all, especially the least of these, your brothers and sisters.

One of the reasons why I like this song is because it acknowledges the honesty that there are troubled times in our lives. We do have days or months when we feel as if we are on our own in the wilderness, when things "are not as they should be". Can we even in those times, give thanks for God's presence with us? We may not be able to do that every day, but hopefully, we can on at least some of those days say, "Blessed be the name of the Lord".

So, in these days of summer, as you watch the growth of your flowers, your garden, and even moan about how fast the grass in the front yard grows, I invite you to think about your growth in faith, your growth in following Jesus. Have you been able to, in times of abundance and in times of desert scarcity, been able to praise the name of God? In times of sunshine and in times of darkness, have you been able to give thanks to God, trusting that God sustains you through the bad as well as the good?

I invite you to worship with us, as we explore this idea of growth. Whether it's in the parking lot, in the sanctuary, or on-line, I look forward to worshipping with you!

Worship Plans


